
All children from kindergarten to the 9th grade (ages 5 to 13) are to enroll in the Religious Education Program. Teenagers (ages 14-16) are to enroll in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC). Registration forms are available in the rear of the church, and in the rectory. Each registration form must be submitted with a clear copy of the following certificates (where applicable):

- Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate
- Reconciliation Certificate
- First Communion Certificate
- Updated Health Form

Registration fees are \$65.00 for Religious Education, and \$70.00 for RCIC.

<u>Diocesan Guidelines</u>: Children must be registered and attend their Parish Sacramental program to be prepared to receive the sacraments, even if they attend a Catholic academy.


