It is that time of the year to update the Sacred Heart Membership database. 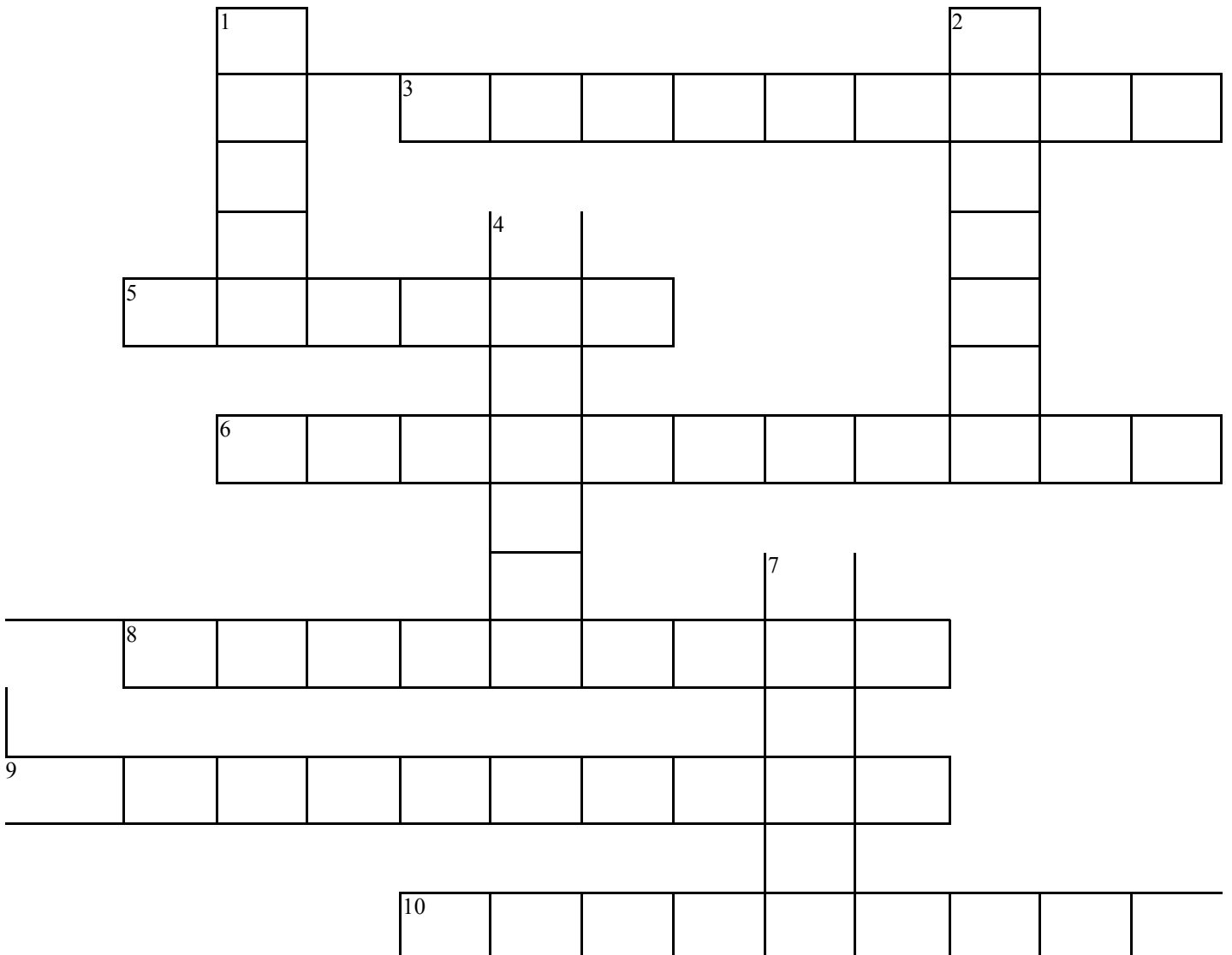
