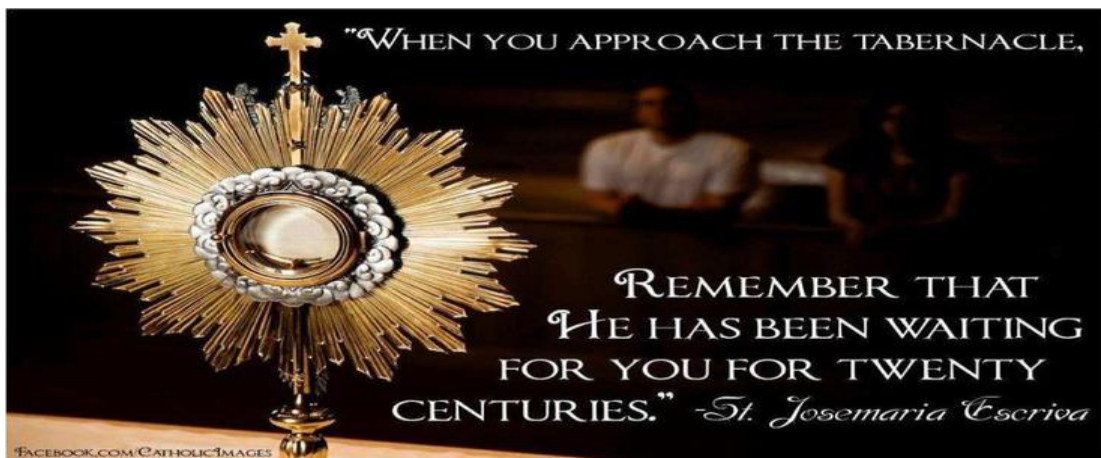

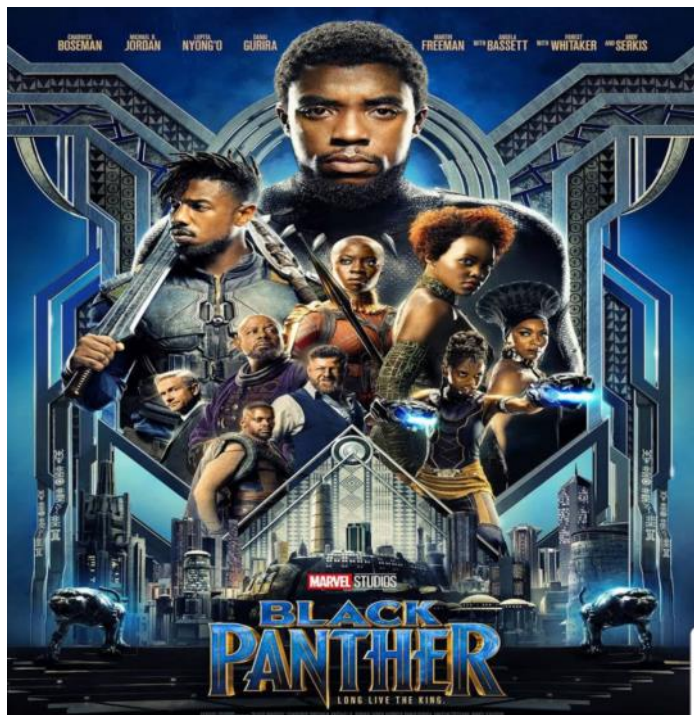


July 6th is 1st Friday of the Month

Consecration of America

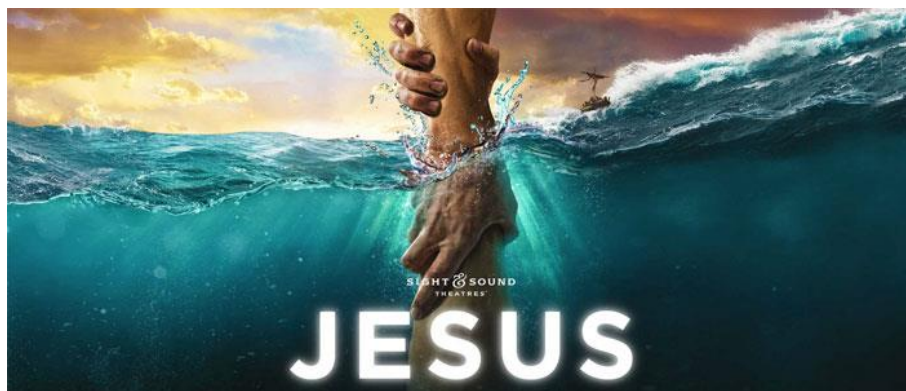
