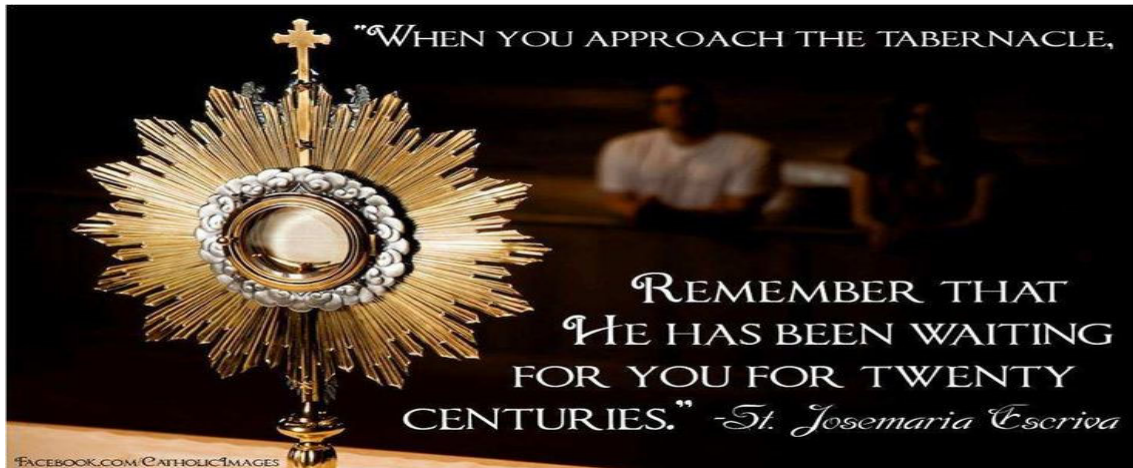

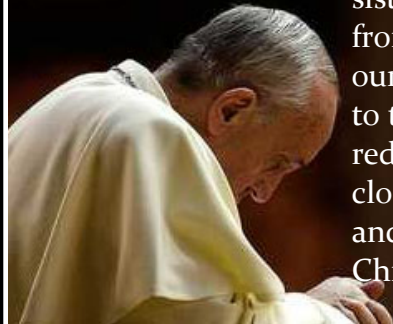

Festive attire would be better served without jeans, t-shirts and sport clothing. Modesty for Men: encouraged to come without shorts or sleeveless shirts. Women are encouraged to come covered from shoulders to knees; without low cuts, strapless or spaghetti straps tops; no miniskirts or shorts and without revealing or tight clothing. ***So before you leave home, ask yourself, does my attire give glory and honor to God? 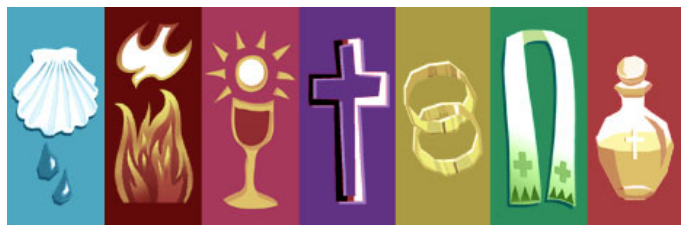
