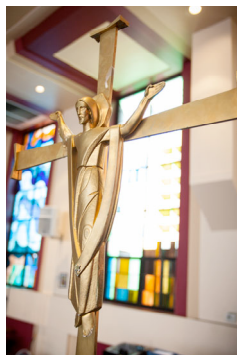

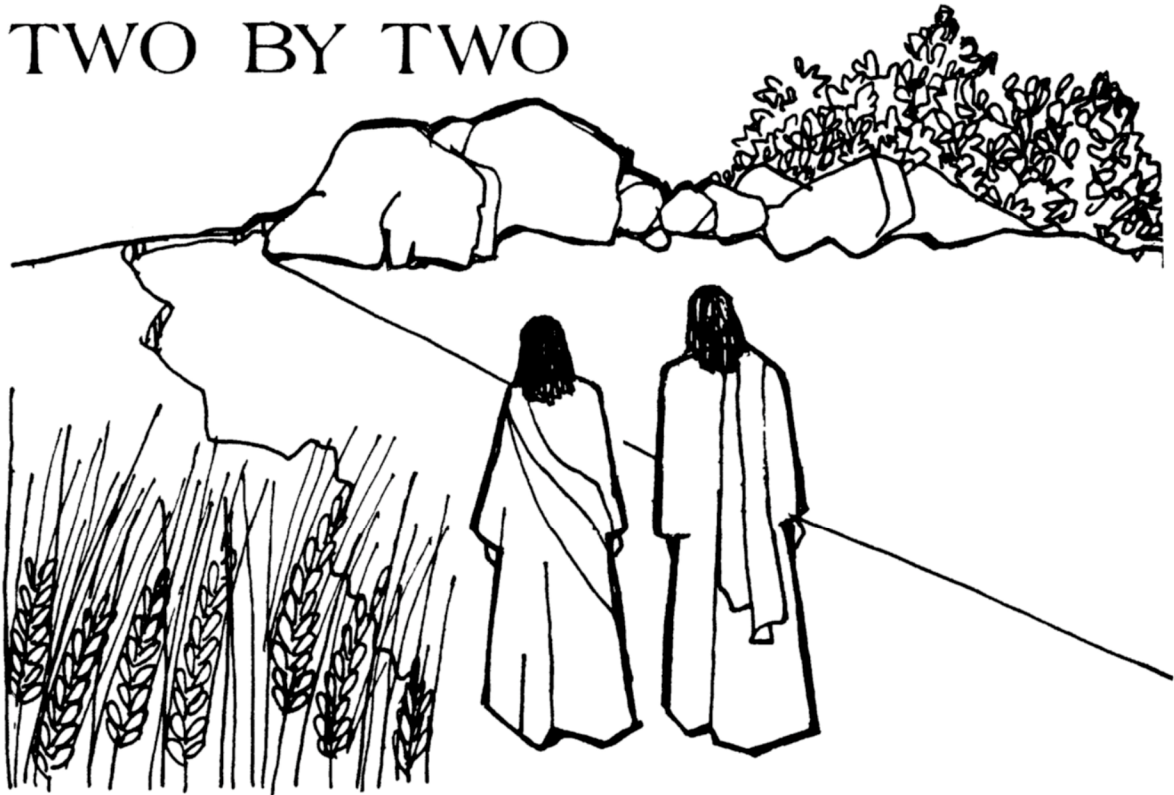

SENT BY GOD

In Amos' time the vocation of prophet had achieved a very formal status in Israel. The prophets had arisen, originally, to act as God's voice when Israel was no longer led by the spiritual/civil figures known as "judges," but by monarchs. Over time, the monarchy had appropriated the offices of priest and prophet, established them into companies, and reserved the right to appoint courtly prophets. Then, as now, when those in power also got to choose who would act as their official conscience, things sometimes went awry. At such times, God raised up prophets from unlikely places, and this is how Amos received his vocation as prophet. In last week's Gospel we heard how Jesus was raised up as God's anointed from a place many viewed as unlikely. As we continue to discern our own vocation as baptized disciples, we can be assured that we are, in Paul's words, "chosen, destined in accord with the purpose of the One who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will" (Ephesians 1:11).

Celebration of the Sacraments

Reconciliation/Confession

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered on Saturdays at 4:00 PM in church, or by appointment in the rectory.

Matrimony

If you are planning to get married, please schedule an appointment with a priest or deacon at least six months before the anticipated wedding date. If you are not in a valid marriage (a marriage not celebrated in church by a priest or deacon), please call or write the rectory for an appointment to see a priest.

Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated in English on the 2nd Saturday at 1:00 PM, and in Creole on the 4th Saturday at 1:00 PM. If you are planning to have your child baptized in the parish, please call the rectory.

Communion for the Homebound

Anyone unable to attend Mass because of illness may receive Holy Communion at home on a regular basis. Please call the rectory.

Religious Education Program

New Parents/Guardians: Registration forms are available for you to register your child for religious classes for the Fall. Please return all forms to the rectory. If your child attends public school and is in Kindergarten through grade 8, he/she should be attending Religious Instructions. If your child attends Catholic School, he/she should be attending preparation classes to receive the Sacraments at Sacred Heart or wherever you worship on Sundays. For more information, please call the rectory.

We are accepting applications for kindergarteners to the 8th graders (ages 5 to 13), even if they attend Catholic Academies. Teenagers (ages 14 to 16) who have not received one of the sacraments of initiation are to register in the Roman Catholic Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC), and adults in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults Program (RCIA). Application forms are available in the back of the church and in the rectory.
