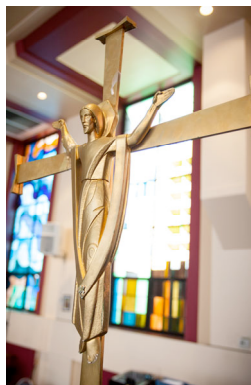

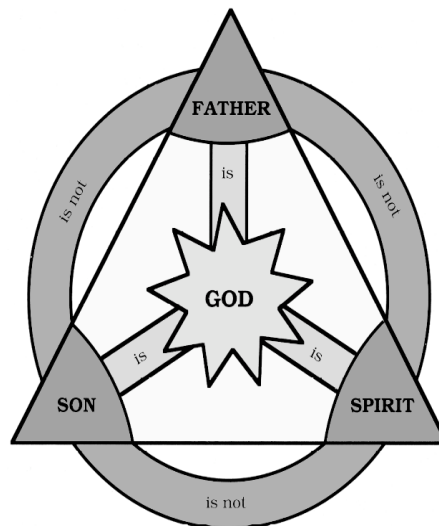


### Parish Mission Statement
