

A LENTEN MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

My dear parishioners of Sacred Heart,

The great season of Lent, which began on Ash Wednesday, allows for forty days of preparation for Easter, the great celebration of the resurrection of our Lord Jesus and our resurrected life. In the liturgy of the Word on Ash Wednesday, Jesus in the gospel urges the disciples not to practice their piety so that they will be praised by others, but to practice piety in such a way that others will be helped and God's name glorified.

The season of Lent, my friends, calls us to Renunciation and Self-Denial. We are to renounce ourselves for the sake of God's kingdom. This must not be simply a Lenten discipline, but it is living our baptismal life in Christ, crucifying the old and bringing the new to life, refocusing our habits, our priorities, and our direction. This self-renunciation during this Lenten Season is much more than the renunciation of some of our petty practices, much more than giving up meat, sweets, and the likes. It is renouncing our way of life, our attitudes, and perspectives. It is renouncing all that prevent us from being children of God and servants to our neighbor. It is in that Lenten spirit that we began our parish's Lenten Mission Project on Wednesday – a project that will go beyond the Lenten season to the very heart of our parish life.


The Parish Mission Project kicked off with the distribution of individual Lenten offering boxes and will continue throughout the season of Lent and beyond. This first chapter will conclude on Holy Thursday at the mass dedicated to the poor, where boxes will be returned and distributed to meet the needs of some of the worthy projects that Sacred Heart parishioners support in various parts of the world.

I am excited to share with you this season of spiritual enrichment, practicing the spiritual disciplines of prayer and fasting, while showing genuine concerns and offering prayers for the issues of the Church, the community, and the least fortunate around the world.
