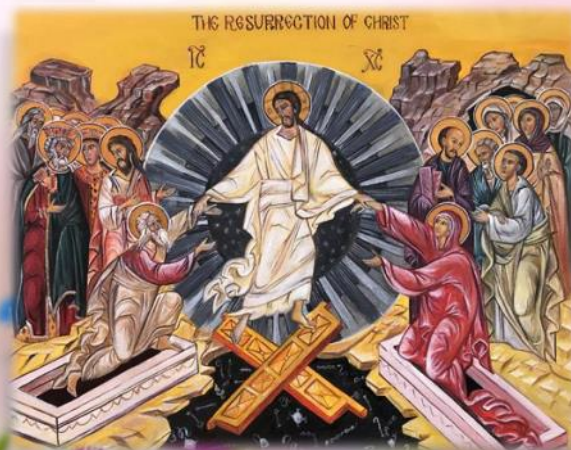

My prayer for all of us this Easter is that we truthfully live as peaceful people, people of the resurrection, people who proclaim by words and deeds that Christ is indeed Risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!

## CANADA PILGRIMAGE

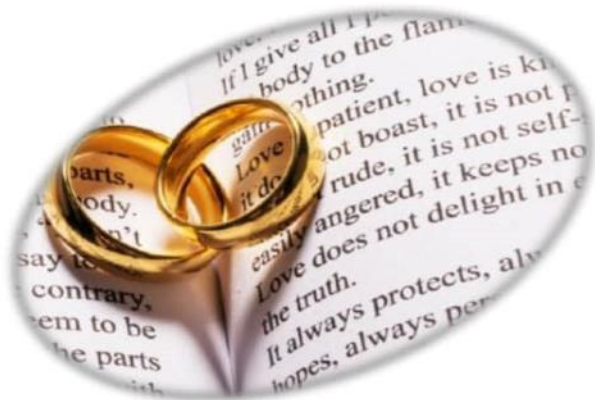

## CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS



### Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated at 1:00 PM in English on the 2nd Saturday of each month and in Creole on the 4th Saturday of each month. If you are planning to have your child baptized in the parish, please call the rectory.

### Reconciliation/Confession

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered on Saturdays at 4:00 PM in church, or by appointment in the rectory.

### Matrimony

If you are planning to get married, please schedule an appointment with a priest or deacon at least six months before the anticipated wedding date. If you are not in a valid marriage (a marriage not celebrated in church by a priest or deacon), please call or write the rectory for an appointment to see a priest.

### Communion to the Homebound

Anyone unable to attend Mass due to illness may receive Holy Communion at home on a regular basis. Please call the rectory to make arrangements.
