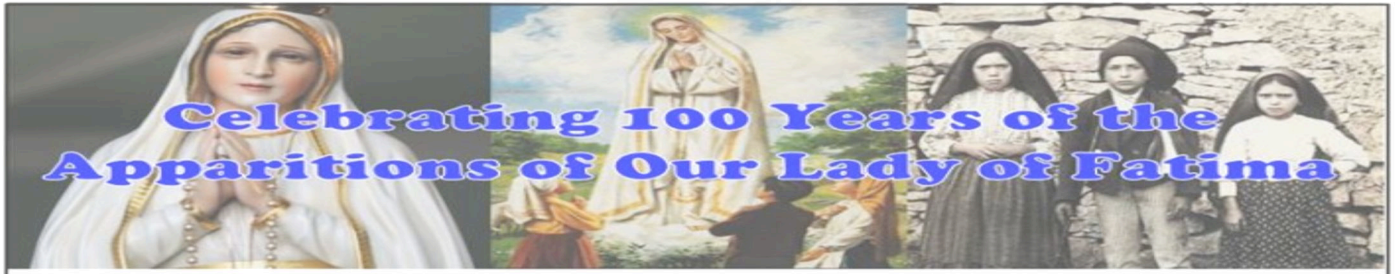
Say this prayer every day for 9 consecutive days May 5-13
