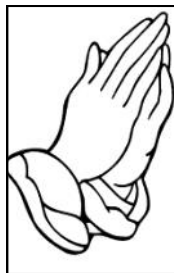

This puzzle is based on Luke 17:5-6

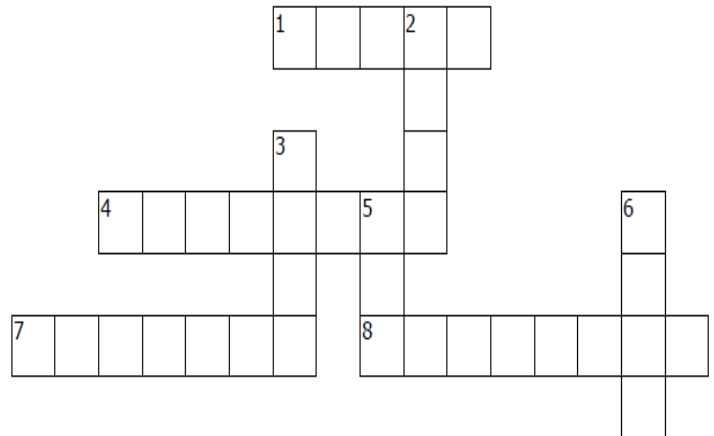


### ACROSS
