present in our world today.

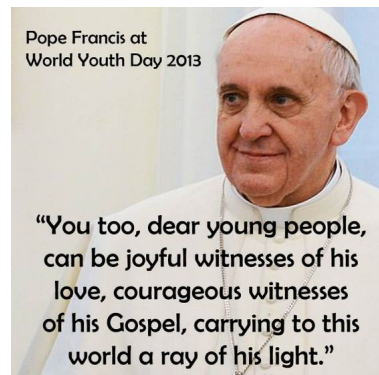
Be with them,

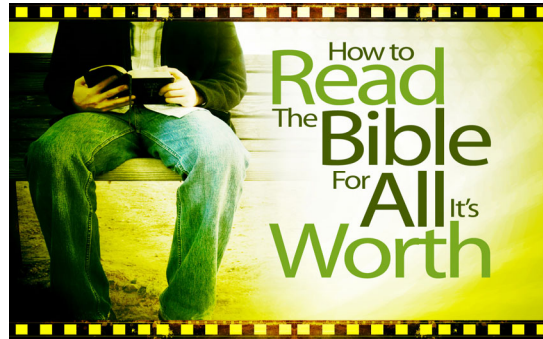

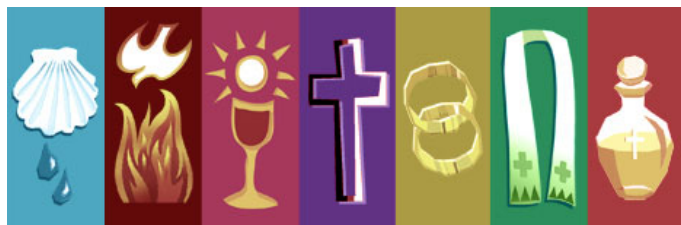
