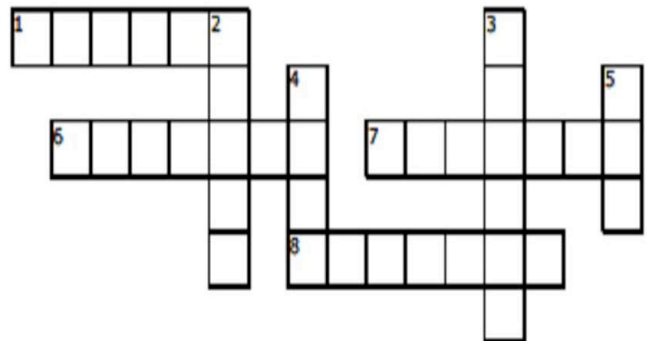
This puzzle is based on Luke 17:11-19 (NIV)
