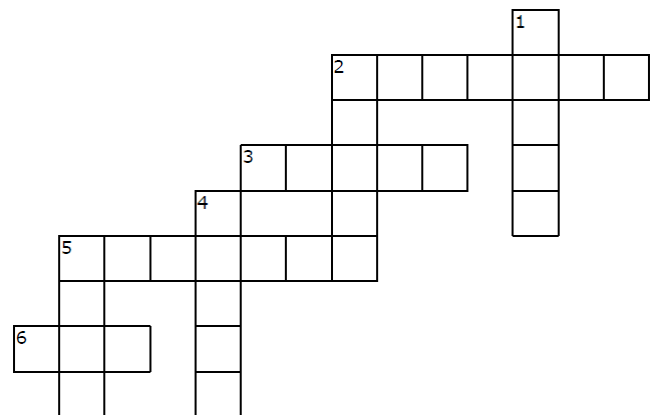
*This puzzle is based on Luke 18:1-8*
