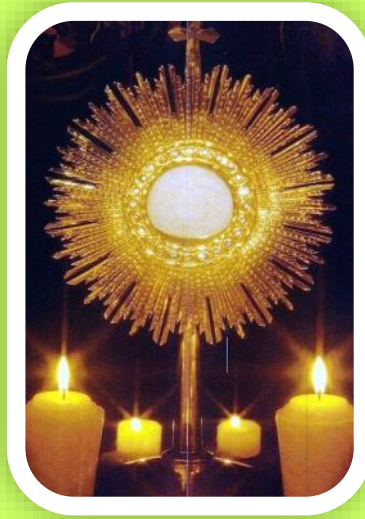

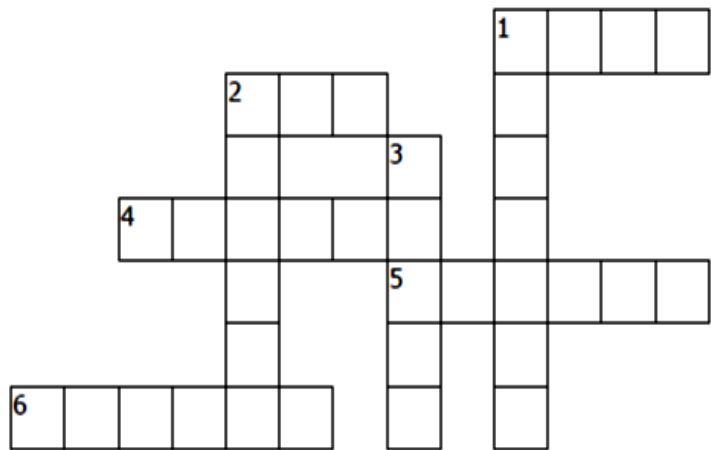
This puzzle is based on Luke 18:9-14
