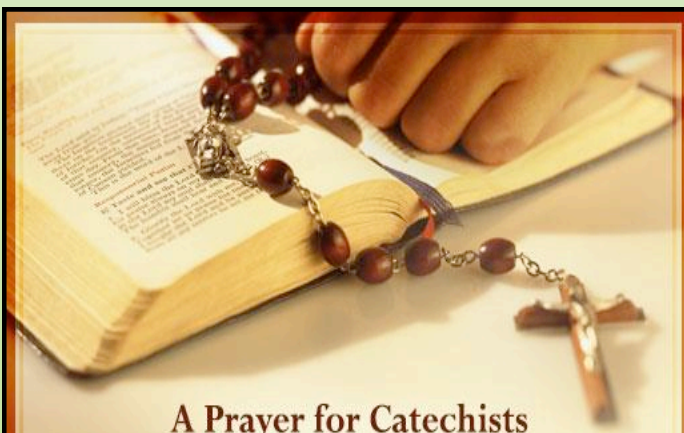

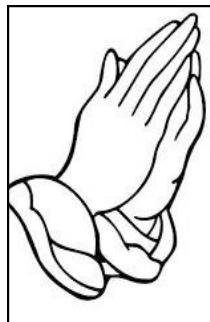

This puzzle is based on Luke 16:1-13

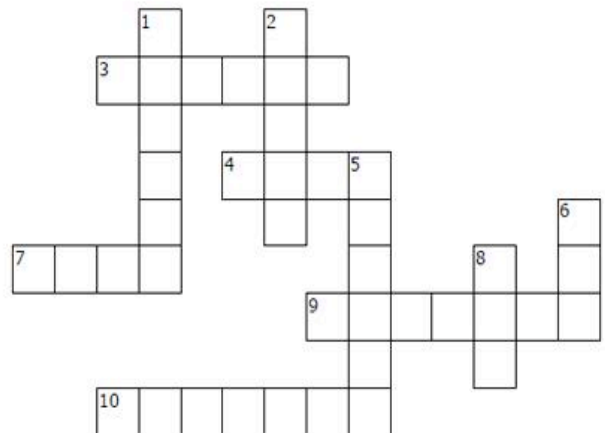
